College of Education Program Requirements Non-Master's Certification-Only Program VOCAL MUSIC EDUCATION K - 12th Grades

To be admitted to any non-master's alternate certification program at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, a candidate must present evidence of having fulfilled each of the following requirements:

Degree: Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university

GPA: Adjusted grade point average of at least a 2.5

Praxis Exams: Passing scores on all sections of the Praxis Pre-Professional Skills Test
Reading (174) Writing (173) Math (172)

Passing scores on the Praxis content test appropriate for the area and/or level
Praxis II Content Area: Music 0113 (151)

Please call the Office of Student Services at (337) 482-6681 to schedule an appointment to have your transcripts and Praxis scores evaluated. Enrollment in the classes listed below is limited to students who have been accepted into the Vocal Music Education non-master's certification-only program.
