To be admitted to any non-master's alternate certification program at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, a candidate must present evidence of having fulfilled each of the following requirements:

**Degree:** Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university

**GPA:** Adjusted grade point average of at least a 2.5

**Praxis Exams:** Passing scores on all sections of the Praxis Pre-Professional Skills Test **or** ACT  $\geq 22$   
**Reading (174)      Writing (173)      Math (172)**

Passing scores on the Praxis content test appropriate for the area and/or level  
**Praxis II Content Area:      Art 0133 (155)**

Please call the Office of Student Services at (337) 482-6681 to schedule an appointment to have your transcripts and Praxis scores evaluated. Enrollment in the classes listed below is limited to students who have been accepted into the Art Education non-master's certification-only program.
